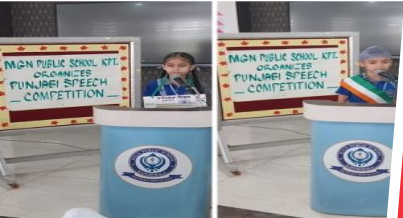

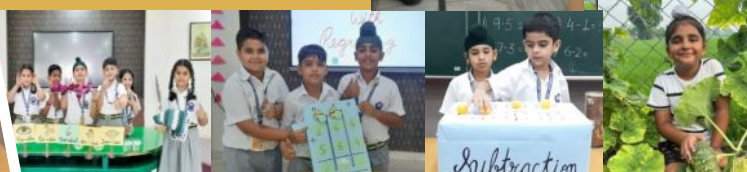

# Days & Celebrations

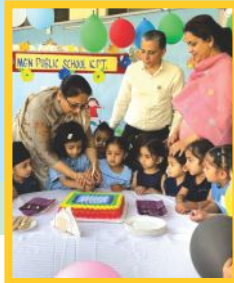

### Rendezvous with our Erudite IPS Officer

1) You have brought laurels to the school. To whom do you attribute your grand success?

I have achieved everything with the grace of God, support of my parents, my wife, my teachers from MGN Public School and all the well wishes of my dear friends.

2) How much credit do you give to your planned hard work and to your luck?

Luck is never a substitute for the hard work. One has to do the required hardwork, strategise well for the luck to operate in your favour. There is a saying by Thomas Jefferson, "I'm a great believer in luck, and I find the harder I work, the more I have of it".

3) There must have been something or the other tempting you to walk away from your books. How did you succeed in avoiding temptations?



I think when something is your passion and you start enjoying doing something, one never feels burdened or tempted with other things. But, there can be burnouts. 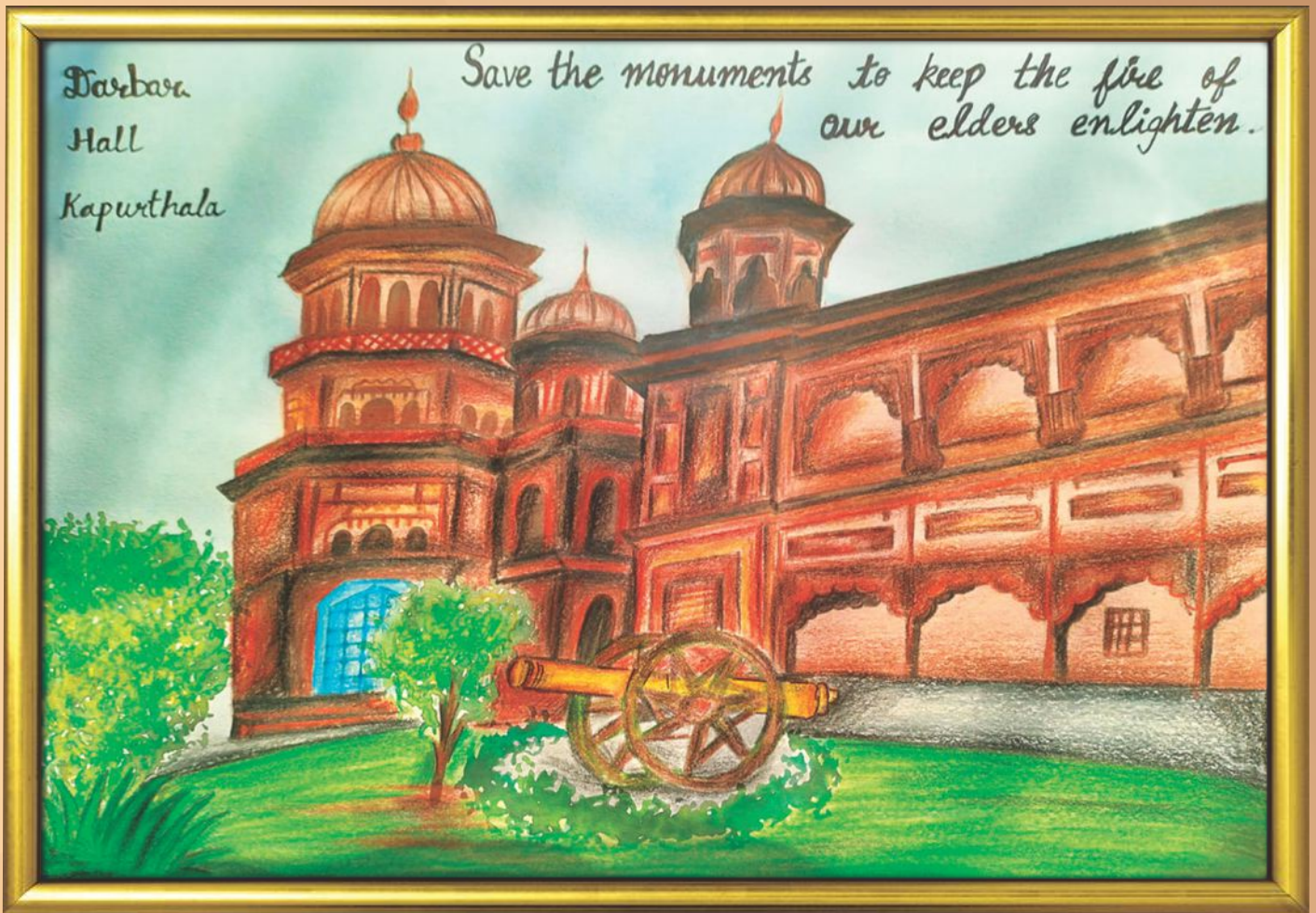
